Subject: Poor performance in Board Examination -remedial action thereof.

Circular

- > Whereas, the performance of some schools in **Board Examination** {2011} was observed unsatisfactory thereby making it a case of serious concern;
- > Whereas, the public investments in the Education sector are increasing with no matching *output* in most of the Institutions.
- > Whereas, studies were conducted at **SIE** and **District level** bringing forth some suggestions and recommendations for the **quality enrichment** of schools;
- ➤ Whereas, teacher absenteeism and lack of proper *accountability* in the ever enlarged school system is required to be checked;

Therefore, the following formulations are ordered;

- The **Head of the Institutions** shall take all measures as may be necessary to ensure full attendance of students and the staff in their schools. They shall seek cooperation from **Panchayat Raj Institutions** and **Village Education Committees**. They shall make the performance of the staff effective & productive by transacting the prescribed syllabi within the specified time frame.
- Besides adopting the poor performing schools, the DIETs shall monitor the functioning of Zonal / Clustral resource centers, and extend complete academic support to the schools on need basis.
- The academic staff shall be allowed to take Board assignment (conduct / evaluation etc) to the maximum period of **20 days** in the entire academic session.
- The academic staff to the maximum extent of **10**% at the same time shall be allowed to take Board assignments in the rotation manner to check the **outstay** of teaching personnel's.
- Only subject practicing teachers from High & Hr. Sec. Schools shall be eligible to take Board assignments (Conduct / Evaluation).
- The **Head of Institutions** shall not take Board assignment without the permission of concerned **Chief Education Officers**.

- The duty on account of Board assignment shall be valid only on the strength of duty certificate and permission from the competent authority.
- The Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall ensure strict adherence to the leave rules and recording of leave thereof in the service records at the time of sanction.
- The Principal SIE, Chief Education Officers & Principal DIETs shall expedite their monitoring mechanism by utilizing the services of field officers viz Dy. Chief Education Officers, ZEOs and ZEPOs. The Head of Institutions shall as such, regularly monitor the academic activities of all the immediate feeding/catchment area schools.
- The performance/ monitoring report form Principal SIE, Chief Education Officers & Principal DIETs should reach to Directorate of School Education Kashmir on 30th of every month.

Any deviation to the above circular instructions shall warrant action against the delinquent officers/officials for exhibiting sense of laxity and irresponsibility in discharging their duties.
