Sub: Un-authorized absence case of Mr. Rashid Ul Hassan Gojer, Teacher, MS Guddar, District Kulgam and removal from services thereof.

Order No: 154 DSEK of 2023 Dated: 21 / 06 /2023

Whereas, Mr. Rashid Ul Hassan Gojer S/o Gh Hassan R/o: Arigatnoo Kulgam was appointed in the Department as teacher vide order No 2034 DSEK of 2007 dated: 17/10/2007 or the recommendations of the JKSSB under ST category in District Cadre Kulgam and was subsequently posted at MS Guddar, Kulgam by the Chief Education officer Kulgam; and

Whereas, the certificates/documents produced by the said incumbent were scrutinized by the Drawing and Disbursing officer concerned and found some variation in qualification/caste certificates and accordingly the issue was taken up with the issuing authorities by the Drawing and Disbursing officer concerned; and

Whereas, the Assistant Controller Tabulation, University of Kashmir vide his letter dated: 28/03/2012 communicated that the certificates submitted by the said candidate namely "Mr. Rashid ul Hassan Gojar" S/o 'Ghulam Hassan Gojar' for BA 3rd Year are fabricated and the marks recorded on the marks certificate are actually of another candidate namely "Rashid ul Hassan" S/o: 'Ghulam Hassan Rather'; and

Whereas, instead of cooperating with the Drawing and Disbursing officer concerned for rectifying his particulars, the incumbent not only remained away from his legitimate duties w.e.f 21/07/2011 but also filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High court under SWP No. 739/2012 titled Rashid-ul Hassan Gojjer Vs State of J&K and others; and

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court disposed off the said writ petition in its order dated: 19/02/2018, operative part of which is reproduced below:

"In this view of the mater, the instant writ petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to make a detailed representation to respondents No. 2 and 3. On such representation being filed the authority shall accord consideration and dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of four to six weeks from the date of receipt of representation along with copy of this order".

Whereas, the DDO concerned served several notices to the said incumbent which was also published in print media viz Greater Kashmir 07/05/2012 for remaining unauthroizedly absent from his legitimate duties; and

Whereas, this office also issued a show cause notice to the teacher vide No. DSEK/Legal/519/12/844-46 dated: 04/07/2019, wherein he was asked to explain his position within 10 days failing which action as warranted in terms of Article 113 of J&K CSR Vol-I of 1956 shall be initiated against him for remaining more than 05 years continuously absent from his legitimate duties un-authroizedly; and

Whereas, the said teacher responded the show cause notice on 16/07/2019, but was found un-satisfactory and un-substantial and accordingly Joint Director (S) School Education Kashmir was appointed as Inquiry officer vide this office Order No. 264 DSEK of 2020 dated: 24/06/2020; and

Whereas, the said Inquiry officer furnished the findings of the inquiry on 22/07/2020, wherein it has been established that the said teacher has not attended his legitimate duties w.e.f 21/07/2011; and

Whereas, the issue was placed before the designated committee constituted for the purpose in its various meetings and latest on 08/04/2022 wherein it was recommended that "to process the case for termination".

Whereas, remaining continuously/un-authorizedly absent from legitimate duties for more than 05 years attracts action as warranted in terms of article 113 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956, which reads as under:-

"After five years of continuous absence on leave an officer is considered to be out of state employee."

Now, therefore, pursuant to the decision of the committee, Mr. Rashid ul Hassan Gojer, Teacher MS Guddar Kulgam is hereby removed from the Government service in terms of Article 113 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956 and Rule 30(VII) of J&KCCA rules 1956.
