Whereas, Smt. Alka Tak Teacher, MS Moran Tangwari, Baramulla remained unauthorizedly absent from her legitimate duties w.e.f 25/09/2015; and

Whereas, the teacher was provided enough opportunities to resume her duties, which she failed to dos so; and

Whereas, the issue was placed before the Designated Committee in its meeting held on 07/06/2021 and after examining the case the committee took the following decision:

"To initiate process for termination of her service being un-authorizedly absent from her legitimate duties w.e.f.25/09/2015 and has completed more than 05 years continously absence".

Whereas, pursuant to the decision passed by the Designated Committee a final show cause notice was served to the said absconding teacher on 07/09/2021 wherein she was asked to explain as to why action as warranted under Article 113 f J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956 shall not be initiated against her for remaining unauthorizedly absent from duties; and

Whereas, the teacher replied to the said notice on 27/09/2021 and on its examination it was found unsatisfactory and unsubstantiated; and

Whereas, un-authorized absence from duties attracts action as warranted in terms of article 128 & 113 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956, which reads as under:-

Article 128

'Absence without leave or after the end of leave involves loss of appointment'

"After five years of continuous absence on leave an officer is considered to be out of state employee."

Now, therefore, pursuant to the decision of the committee Smt. Alka Tak Teacher, MS Moran Tangwari, Baramulla is hereby removed from the service of the state in terms of Article 113 & Article 128 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956 and Rule 30(VII) of J&KCCA rules 1956.

Whereas, Ms. Rubeena Kakroo was appointed in the Department as Teacher in District Cadre Baramulla on 24/06/2009 for a probation period of two years and subsequently posted in MS Pir Mohalla; and

Whereas, after joining the services it was observed that the teacher is habitual of remaining un-authorizedly absent from her legitimate duties and used to go abroad without obtaining prior permission from the competent authority; and

Whereas, the issue was enquired by the CEO Baramulla and it was reported that the teacher hardly attended her duies for 57 days in the institution, rest of period she remained unauhtorizedly absent till 01/10/2011, and thereafter remained continuously absent from her legitimate duties; and

Whereas, the said teacher was provided enough opportunities to resume her duties followed by notice by this Directorate on 14/06/2021, wherein she was again provided an opportunity for hearing before taking action in terms of Article 113 of J&K CSR Vol -I of 1956; and

Whereas, the teacher responded the said notice on 26/06/2021 and after examing the same it was found that the said reply is unsatisfactory and unsubstinate; and

Whereas, the issue was placed before the Designated Committee held on 04/08/2021 and the committee after examining the case took a following decision:

"deemed to have been out of Government service and formal termination order be issued in terms of Article 113 of J&K CSR Vol -I of 1956".

Whereas, un-authorized/continuous absence of an Government employee attracts action as warranted in terms of Article 113 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956 which reads as under:-

Article 113

"After five years of continuous absence on leave an officer is considered to be out of state employee."

Now, therefore, Ms. Rubeena Kakroo Teacher MS Pir Mohalla, Baramulla is hereby removed from Government service in terms of Article 113 of J&K Civil Services Rules (Volume I) of 1956 read with Rule 30 (vii) of J&KCCA Rules 1956.
