CIRCULAR

From time to time detailed circular instructions have been issued to all the heads of the High and Higher Sec. Schools of Kashmir province wherein blanket ban stands imposed on any kind of detention in Class 10th and 12th. In spite of such clear instructions, it has been reported that some Heads of the Institutions on one pretext or the other debar students from appearing as regular candidates in the Board examinations to manipulate high percentage of result. This un-called for practice resorted to by such School managements is in gross violation of standing instructions which not only contribute to the deterioration of the academics in the Schools but also brews resentment among the student community unnecessarily.

It is once again enjoined upon all the Heads of High and Higher Sec. Schools (both Govt. as well as Private) to desist from such practice. They will ensure punctuality of the students in their respective institutions so that uncovered portion of syllabus is completed within the stipulated time. Any deviation in this regard if noticed will be viewed seriously and stern action will be taken against such defaulters.
