

Adoption of Atal Pension Yojana by State-Government for Unorganized Sector

Atal Pension Yojana was launched by Govt. of India in May, 2015 for the Citizens of India who are in the age group of 18-40 years, specially targeting the poor and the under-privileged sections of society in the unorganized sector which constitutes about 88% of the total work force in the country and contributes significantly to the country's economy. As on date, around 3.5 Crore subscribers are enrolled under APY across the country, while in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir, enrolments under APY are 1,00,000.

This scheme being administered by PFRDA, provides a guaranteed minimum monthly pension of Rs. 1000 to Rs 5000, after attaining the age of 60 years. A subscriber can join the Scheme through any bank branch or Post Office which is on CBS platform or through e-APY portal provided by Central Recordkeeping Agency-NSDF. The prerequisite for opening an APY account is to have a Savings Bank (SB) Account with any bank branch/India Post.

The scheme has three major benefits, a guaranteed minimum pension for the life of the subscriber after attaining the age of 60 years, the same pension to the spouse in case of subscriber's death, and return of the corpus accumulated till 60 years age of the subscriber, to the nominee after death of both the subscriber and the spouse. The scheme details are enclosed for ready reference.

We understand that in the states, multiple unorganized workers like Organized workers, Asha workers, construction laborers etc are attached to different ministries/departments like Labor & Construction Worker's Board Health & Family Welfare, Women and Child Development, Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, etc. These ministries/departments may consider adopting APY for all such workers, as a measure of social welfare and financial security in their old age. Even State Government may consider enrolling its citizens through Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) of Ministry of Panchayati Raj and National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) of Ministry of Rural Development Govt. of India.


