1	That the University/institution awarding the degrees through distance mode are UGC recognized and Established by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature.	
2	The courses offered are approved by Distance Education Council (DEC)/ All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).	
3	The in service candidate, who have acquired their degree through Distance Mode prior to the issuance of Jammu & Kashmir Private Colleges (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2005, notified vide SRO-339 of 2005, dated 20.12.2005, shall be treated as recognized/ valid, provided the Universities/ institutions from which they have obtained their degrees are recognized as per UGC guidelines and are DEC/ AICTE approved	
4	The courses in Science subjects where practicals are part of the curriculum, the concerned University shall certify that the practicals have been conducted from the main campus of the University as envisaged in Clause (VI) of the Government Order No. 252-HF of 2012, dated 30.05.2012.	
5	The in-service candidates, who have obtained degrees in B.Ed/ M.Ed courses through Distance Mode from Universities of Kashmir/ Jammu/ IGNOU or any other UGC- recognized university shall be considered as valid degree for effecting their promotion, provided these degrees are also DEC-approved	
6	The degrees obtained through Distance Education Mode from off-campuses which have been established by the State Universities beyond their territorial jurisdiction shall not be recognized.	
7	The in-service candidates have obtained their degrees after seeking proper permission from the Competent Authority at the relevant point of time.	
8	The promotion of in-service candidates, including Distance Mode degree-holders, shall be performance-based and their regularization will be effected strictly as per their last three years' performance in their respective disciplines	
9	While verifying and considering the degrees obtained through Distance Mode by the in-service candidates, the concerned authorities shall ensure strict compliance of the directions passed by the Hon'ble Courts.	
10	The in-service candidates, who have obtained their degrees through Distance Mode from the UGC-recognized Universities for the courses approved by DEC/ AICTE shall have to produce bonafide certificate in Form 'A' appended to this Order, before concerned Directors of School Education	
11	The concerned Directors shall verify the degrees in light of the above conditions. Status of permission and admissibility of leave and thereafter, recommend the cases to the Administrative Department for further appropriate action.	
12	The degrees obtained in contravention to the conditions taid down herein above or submitted without the bonafide certificate and clear-cut recommendations of the concerned Directors shall not be entertained for seniority /promotion purposes.	
13.	Clear-cut recommendations of Director, whether eligible for inclusion in seniority / promotion in light of G.O No. 940-Edu of 2017 Dated 17.11.2017.
